Top two teams qualify for semi-finals, group order decided as follows (Junior Competition Rule K):

**K. Final Pool Order**

1. Shall be decided on total match points.
2. If two or more teams are equal on match points at the end of their pool, the winner shall be decided by considering the games between those teams.<sup>3</sup>
  - 1) During tie breaking any team which is given the top place or eliminated to the lower place will be removed from the tie, and the process repeated until the tie is resolved.
  - 2) If match points in the games between tied teams produce a clear leader that team will take the top place.
  - 3) If there is still a tie, then sets difference will be used.
  - 4) If there is still a tie, then point difference will be used.
3. Only if the tie break procedure does not resolve the tie will overall sets difference and points difference be used to resolve the tie.
4. Play-off as decided by the Competitions Commissioner.

<sup>3</sup>Head to head process is preferred to avoid the affect of a strong leader, playing bench players in later rounds giving an advantage to the team that plays against the bench players.
