

Volleyball England - Lead for Children and Young People

Term: 4 years from 2022 AGM

Responsible to: Get Keep Grow sub group

Remuneration: This is a voluntary role. Any reasonable out of pocket-expenses will be met in accordance with the Association's Expenses Claim Policy.

The Lead for Children and Young People will have a focussed remit over the coming 1-2 years on supporting the effective role out of the Volley 2 programme as well as the development of Volley 3 and Volley 4 – volleyball programmes designed to support education establishments to implement volleyball with key stage 3 and 4 children.

Your role will expect you to develop a working group to:

- To support the strategic development, delivery, implementation, and evolution of activities to support the engagement of C&YP within the sport of volleyball (all disciplines)
- Working with the Board, hub team, sub-groups and other Working Groups to ensure the welfare and safeguarding of all C&YP and those working with C&YP
- Collaborating with the officials and coaches Working Group to ensure there are coaches and officials to support sitting volleyball's development
- Obtain regular feedback and ensure all activities and delivery of the Working Group remain current, meet the changing needs of C&YP and deliver the Game Plan
- Support (including support to Sitting & CY&P Working Groups) the creation of innovative and dynamic competitions that lead the way in engaging new participants in volleyball whilst also generating a commercial return
- Support to regional/county associations on CY&P development and ideas as requested from time to time
- Collaboration with other Working Groups, Sub-group and Hub activity as agreed from time to time

Key skills, experience and qualifications required:

- Have a commitment to supporting the strategic direction of Volleyball England;
- Have an awareness, understanding, and appreciation the needs of the Volleyball England membership and in particular Coaches
- A willingness to work collaboratively with the sub group and Board
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills handles complex and difficult situations with thought and confidence
