Volleyball Futures

Volleyball Futures supports the development of young players who aspire to play for England.

At Volleyball Futures camps young players learn the essential volleyball fundamentals they need to make it onto the England Talent Pathway.

At Volleyball Futures camps young players experience a National Team camp environment and find out what it is like to train like an England athlete. They get the opportunity to work with National Team coaches and find out what is expected of an England athlete. They learn about the volleyball fundamentals how to practice them and why they are so important to get right to be a top volleyball player.

At the camp the players will:

- have three volleyball training sessions, led by national team coaches
- get advice on what to do to improve
- have a chance to win prizes by entering challenges and competitions
- get a Volleyball Futures 2021 T- shirt

Cost £54, which includes coaching, court hire, a hot meal, and a Volleyball Futures T – Shirt.

How to book

There are two parts to the booking process: part one is an online form to gather information about the athletes and permission from parents/guardian and part two is payment. You need to complete both parts to secure a place on the camp. You will receive confirmation of your place, and a Welcome Pack that tells you what to bring, on 22nd October 2021.

Part 1

Code of Conduct/Athlete Agreement

Please read the code of conduct on the next page carefully. It sets out Volleyball England's expectations of Volleyball Futures participants. You and your parents need to sign the parent and athlete agreement that says you will abide by the code of conduct during the booking process.

Parental Permission

Volleyball England is only responsible for players during the camp in the National Volleyball Centre. Parents are responsible for their child's travel arrangements to and from the NVC. players must be collected promptly at the end of the camp.

Permission to take photographs

If you wish to take photographs during the Futures camp, you will need to complete a Photography and Video Recording Registration Form on the day and get a permit.

- I will not leave the National Volleyball Centre at any time during the camp.
- I agree that a full report of any misconduct be forwarded to my parents/guardians if so required.

Venue and Accommodation



By Car

By Taxi

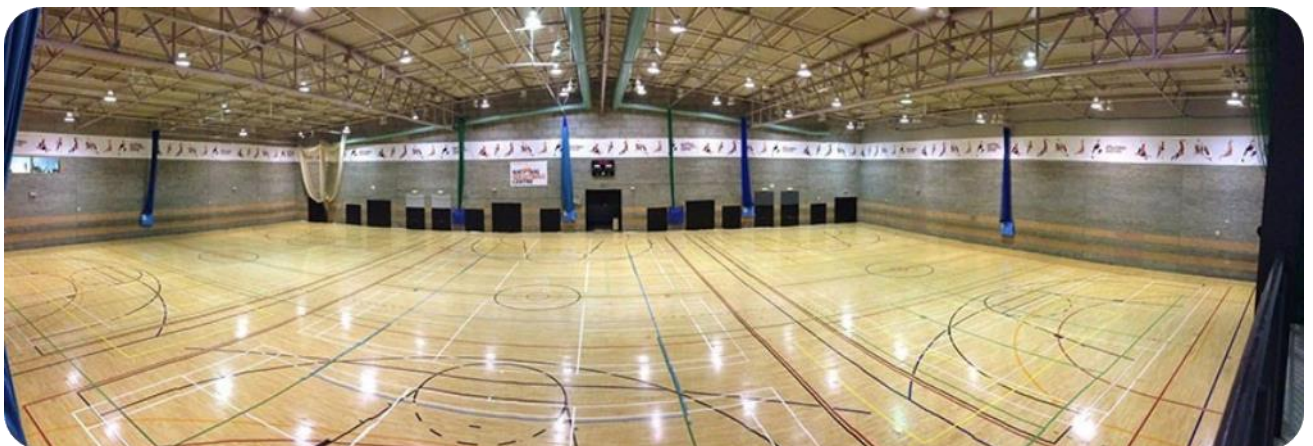
If you require a taxi during the weekend, we recommend Premier Taxis Kettering. Tel: 01536 484484.

Accommodation

There are some great hotels in the area. We recommend the [Holiday Inn Express Kettering](#). Volleyball England members get discount if at the time of your online booking you use the Code 954305266 in the Corporate ID field.

Facilities

Indoor Arena: This is 2000m² space made up of 4 volleyball courts.



Beach Volleyball Courts: Kettering has 3 beach courts with sand that came from the London 2012 Olympics! These are used during beach volleyball camps.



Club Room: This overlooks the indoor arena and provides a space for classroom-based learning, workshops, group work and team discussions, as well as some down time in between camp training sessions. Talent pathway players can also use this as a study space should they need to do exam revision or school work.

Viewing Balcony: This overlooks the indoor arena and provides a limited standing space for parents. Parents are welcome to stay and watch we just politely ask you to refrain from taking chairs on to the viewing balcony as this is against the venue's fire regulations. Thank you.

Parents visiting can purchase refreshments from the reception area and the Balance Café located to the side of the building. Whilst parents and guardians are welcome to stay at the venue there is also a broad range of shops, restaurants and other amenities close by if you wish to explore.

Setting up a VolleyZone account

All transactions are made through [VolleyZone](#). This means the player will need to have a VolleyZone account. As a parent if you already have a VolleyZone account go to Step 2.

If you do not have a VolleyZone account start at Step 1.

1. You can refer to the [‘Registering as a new user’](#) video, [‘Activating your account’](#) video and [‘Completing your profile’](#) video to guide you through the set up process. **Please select ‘parent’ as the volleyball role in the drop-down box on the main registration page unless you currently have another role within Volleyball England such as a coach or referee.**
2. Once you have set up an account you will need to create a child account within your parental account, you can refer to the [‘Creating a child account’](#) video. All details and communication for your child can be managed within the same account. This is particularly important for athletes under 18 years of age.

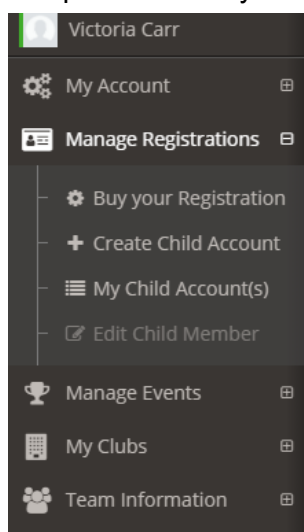


Note: you will need to have photos ready for your account and your child account. Your registration cannot be complete without them. If you do not upload photos you will see a yellow banner appear at the top of the screen asking you to complete your profile. Click on the camera image to upload your photo (see photo to the right), You must press ‘submit’ at the bottom to save the changes.

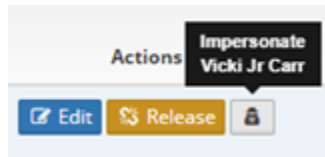
You only need to complete this registration process once, if your child is selected you will use the same account and registration process to book onto national training camps and competitions.

Registering and paying

1. Once you have set up the child account you will need to ‘impersonate’ your child to book them on to the event. To do this, click on ‘Manage Registrations’ in the left-hand panel then ‘My Child Accounts’, see screenshot below.

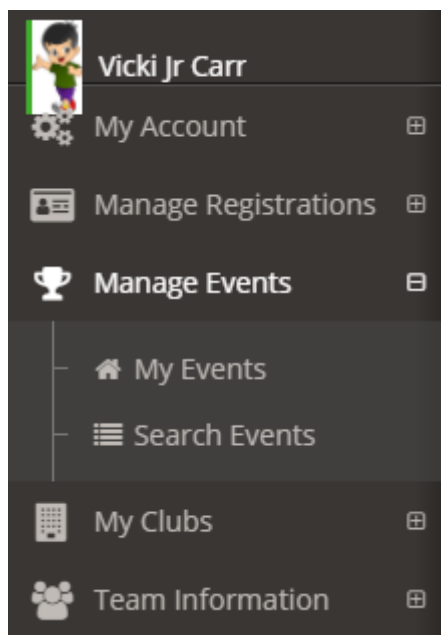


2. Your child's details will then appear on screen. Click on the 'impersonate' button to the right of the screen, see screenshot below.



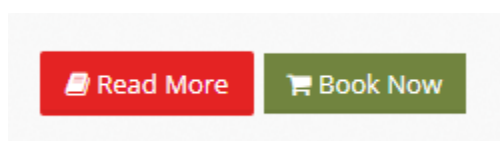
3. The page will refresh, and your child's account will appear on screen.

4. Then, click on 'Manage Events' in the left-hand panel then 'Search Events', see screenshot below.



5. A list of upcoming events will appear. You will need to search for " Futures" in search bar.

6. Then click 'Book now', see screenshot below.



7. A pop up will ask you if you want to add the event to your cart, click 'yes'.

8. Your cart will be updated in the top right-hand corner of the screen, see screenshot below. Then, click on the cart.



9. The page will refresh, and a screen will appear with your chosen event. Please make sure that this the correct event you want to book on to and that the selection box is ticked. There is no voucher code. Click the green 'Checkout' button then click 'yes' to proceed to payment.

10. Then, click 'Proceed' then click 'yes' when the pop up comes up asking you to agree to the terms.
11. The page will refresh, and you will then be able to continue through the process of entering your card details to make final payment.
12. You have registered and paid!

Refunds

If a player is not able to attend the Futures camp once they have registered the following applies:

- If it is more than ten working days before the start of the camp – full refund or transfer on to the next camp.
- If it is less than ten working days before the start of the camp – no refund

Exceptional Circumstances

Refunds may be considered in very exceptional circumstances and only if Volleyball England has not already paid for the goods or services. Each case will be considered individually.
