Location: Given the nature of the role, it is envisaged that the successful individual will be based within Birmingham during days worked.

Volleyball England are looking for a passionate and committed individual to drive community volleyball development in Birmingham. The individual must have a genuine interest in volleyball, along with experience and skills in driving engagement throughout communities. They must be a self-starter, proactive and able to manage multiple projects at the same time.

Deliverables:

1. Embed yourself into the Birmingham volleyball community through engagement with the West Midlands Volleyball Association and existing affiliated clubs.
2. Work with Starbank School and Birmingham City VC to establish a flourishing player pathway and community volleyball opportunities.
3. Work with Bishop Challoner School to grow community volleyball opportunities.
4. Identify and establish a second community volleyball club in Birmingham.
5. Undertake a series of volleyball sessions in the Birmingham area to:
 - a. Engage low economic communities
 - b. Upskill teachers/coaches
 - c. Engage new talent
 - d. Drive activity to the B2022 Beach legacy sites and community clubs
6. Plan and lead beach volleyball events/taster days/sessions at B2022 beach legacy sites to engage the local community and wider volleyball community.
7. Assist in major Birmingham beach volleyball events where necessary.
8. Map wider opportunities to grow community volleyball in the Birmingham area.
9. Manage the Workforce Development aspect of the I&D fund.
10. At 6th months and 12months produce an impact report on progress.

- 5 years of volleyball experience as player, coach, or volunteer (ideally beach)
- Experience in creating and managing projects
