## Terms and conditions for the Prize Draw

- 1. The Promoter of this Prize Draw is Volleyball England, SportPark, Loughborough University, 3 Oakwood Drive, Loughborough, LE11 3QF
- 2. This Prize Draw is open to UK residents aged 16 who have booked onto one of Volleyball England's online Commonwealth Games Activator Courses, which are taking place between 11<sup>th</sup> 22<sup>nd</sup> July. The Prize Draw is not open to employees of Volleyball England, their families, agents, or any third party directly associated with the administration of this prize draw.
- 3. To enter the Prize Draw you must successfully have completed the online activator training, organised a 'come and try it' session and reported information on attendees, including numbers, to Volleyball England by 00:01 on 1st October 2022.
- 4. Only one entry per club is permitted. Therefore, only one member from each club represented on the activator training dates will go into the draw.
- 5. If there are fewer than 15 learners attending the combined course dates, one winner will be selected. Two winners will be selected if between 15-30 learners attended the course dates. If there are more than 30 people attending the course dates three winners will be selected.
