5 Feed into return to play	As of the date of the meeting neither the DCMS or Sport England had published any guidance. It seems that with the Delta variant, with increasing cases and increasing hospitalisations. Further relaxations maybe delayed. The good news is that the current regulations allow most volleyball to take place.
