INTERIM EVALUATION REPORT HIGHLIGHTS PROGRESS OF THE SPORT WELFARE OFFICER NETWORK

The Active Partnerships National Organisation (APNO) has released a summary of its interim evaluation report on the Sport Welfare Officer (SWO) Network, offering valuable insight into progress towards the early outcomes.

Conducted by independent evaluators Ecorys UK and Professor Melanie Lang of Edge Hill University, the report reflects data gathered between September 2024 and March 2025 through SWO data collection, club journey mapping, NGB feedback surveys and reflective practice.

The report reveals strong engagement with National Governing Bodies (NGBs), with each Active Partnership working with an average of **28** NGBs. SWOs across the network have participated in a total of **364** events and between them have supported **556** initiatives, helping to improve safeguarding standards, inclusive practices, and governance across sports clubs.

During this period, more than **2,700** clubs received light-touch guidance, while nearly **640** clubs benefitted from intensive one-to-one support and training, covering key areas like safeguarding procedures and recommended role-specific training.

GOOD PRACTICE FROM ACROSS THE **NETWORK**

Liz Wright, the SWO at **Active Cumbria**, was approached by the Chair of Carlisle Aquatics for support to organise swimming specific training on neurodiversity. Carlisle Aquatics really wanted to understand how to support more neurodiverse participants. Because of the fantastic level of interest from clubs all over Cumbria, two courses were arranged. The first one was really well attended and the second is due to take place very soon.

Anita Stewart, the SWO at **Active Norfolk**, is developing 'Mindful Clubs' – an initiative which upskills club volunteers to become Wellbeing Champions, to foster more supportive club environments.

Volunteers and coaches are provided with free mental health training with NHS Norfolk and Waveney Talking Therapies, to help recognise when someone may need some support.

Wellbeing Champions learn how to approach someone and start a conversation, as well as how to signpost to the Wellbeing Service for support. After the training, they receive a PDF booklet with all the information covered and a comprehensive FAQ guide with resources for their club.

Active Sussex has developed an animation to serve as an engaging and accessible way to inform and inspire clubs and club welfare officers about the free, local, and professional support available. The video provides a quick, visual, and engaging asset that conveys key messages concisely, allowing clubs to absorb important information. It is also a handy tool for NGBs and other partners to share across their networks.



A Gymnastics Club has recently been supported by Richard Bell the Sport Welfare Manager at **Active Lincolnshire**. Richard supported its club welfare officer to review and rewrite its antibullying policy which was later approved by the club's committee.

On the support received, the club said

"Having tried on several occasions to strengthen our anti-bullying policy, the help received brought this to a satisfactory conclusion"

To help deepen relationships between Active Partnerships and Badminton England (BE), SWOs Lijana Kaziow, **Northamptonshire Sport**, and Veronique Nani, **Be Active**, were invited to run a workshop in July at BE's Directorate Day.

This was a brilliant opportunity to bring to life BE's 'A Sport that Cares' campaign, discuss everyone's role in prevention and where opportunities exist across different departments, to signpost to the SWO network.
